GENERAL RULES

1. **Entry forms are due by 5 p.m., Thursday June 18th (postmarks of June 18th will be accepted).**
2. Exhibitors must use separate entry forms for each judging period. Also, separate entry forms must be used for decorated cake, clothing textiles and tablesettings.
3. Entries must have been prepared by the exhibitor within one year prior to the opening date of the fair.
4. No group entries unless otherwise stated.
5. Limit two (2) entries per exhibitor per class, unless otherwise stated.
6. Items entered in *any other* classes must be described in detail on the entry form.
7. Receiving and releasing dates and times will be strictly enforced as per state rules.
8. Unless otherwise specified, all exhibits must remain on display for the duration of the fair.
9. All state & local rules apply.
10. TYPE or PRINT NEATLY all information except signatures.
11. Tablesettings require in-person sign ups, and **MUST BE LISTED ON A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM.**
12. Each item must be listed separately and specifically on entry form.

Spices may be added. **CONSERVE:** Similar to marmalade, made with 2 or more fruits. Nuts and raisins are usually used, but are not required. **JAM:** A preserve that is cooked until it is pulp. **MARMALADES:** Use fruits that have jellying properties containing slices, small pieces or peel of the fruits in the jelly. **JELLY** should be clear. **PRESERVES:** Whole fruit or uniform pieces of the fruit cooked slowly so that the pieces

retain their shape and do not become pulp. **RELISH:** Prepared from fruit and/or vegetables that are chopped, seasoned, and then cooked to desired consistency. **STANDARD CANNING JAR:** Glass container specifically designed for canning. **NON-ACID FOODS:** All vegetables, meats, poultry and fish must be canned under pressure. **LOW-ACID FRUIT,** such as figs, should be made more acidic by adding lemon juice, as directed in the University Agriculture Extension Service leaflet "Home Canning of Fruits." Tomatoes and fruits (including their juices) must be processed in a boiling water bath.

5. Exhibitor's must submit two 750 ml bottles per wine entry, and two 12 or 22 ounce bottles per brew entry. One bottle will be used for display (per entry); the others will be opened for judging. All bottles become property of the Stanislaus County Fair and will be disposed of unless prior arrangements have been made with the Department Superintendent for release.
6. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE CORRECTLY AND CLEARLY LABELED. Label must be attached to each bottle with a rubber band. **NO TAPE OR GLUE PLEASE.**
7. All entries will be kept in a temperature-controlled environment prior to judging.
8. All state and local rules apply.
