2. ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED BY EXHIBITOR, AND PROJECT LEADER OR ADVISOR, AND MUST INCLUDE AGE OF THE EXHIBITOR.
3. All entries must be products of the exhibitor's regular instruction in Ag Mechanics for the past year.
4. The exhibitor must have been the major contributor to the construction or repair of the entry.
5. Entries may not be shown more than one calendar year, from Fair to Fair.
6. NOTE: Any project shown at any State, County or District Fair must be shown within the same calendar year.
7. LIMIT: 2 entries per same pattern.
8. NOTE: All projects that do not receive a placing MUST be picked up on Thursday, July 30th between 8 a.m. and 1 p.m. or they will be discarded. FFA Ag Leaders will be notified after judging.
9. Display cards must be filled out (for medium & large projects) attached to each entry and must include correct labeling of the exhibit, and a brief summary of the project.
