2. **Pictures must be taken by the exhibitor, no duplicate photos will be accepted.**
3. **PHOTOS MUST BE 5"X 7" OR LARGER AND MOUNTED.** The photo mount cannot be more than 1/4" thick (no construction paper), and size of entry cannot exceed 12" x 18". Photos can be mounted by placing photo on top of mount board.

Photo Entry Descriptions

ALTERNATIVE IMAGE MANIPULATION:

Change, modify or alteration of original photo

ANIMALS:

Concentrate on animals, posed or candid.

BIRDS:

Concentrate on birds, posed or candid.

FLORAL:

Concentrate on flowers.

Photo Entry Descriptions (continued)

LANDSCAPES:

Concentrate on a natural scene - avoid man-made objects.

PEOPLE & CHILDREN:

May show people or children doing everyday things, or may be a portrait, posed or candid.

SEASCAPE:

Concentrate on ocean-related scenery.

STILL LIFE:

Inanimate objects only: vase, lamp (no people or moving subjects and no fresh living floral)

ANY OTHER SUBJECT:

Only for entries that are not eligible for entry in any other listed class

COLLAGE:

Use 5 different prints, any size, on one mounting board. Mounting board size cannot be larger than 12"X18".

Concentrate on theme (the photos should tell a story to the viewer).
