**SPICE UP YOUR NIGHT WITH LOS TUCANES AT
THE STANISLAUS COUNTY FAIR**

Turlock, CA (April 22, 2010) – Sensational Mexican regional band Los Tucanes will take the stage on the final night of this summer’s Stanislaus County Fair.

Los Tucanes has created an image for themselves as one of the most influential Latin artists. Come see them perform at the **Stanislaus County Fair, Sunday, July 25, 2010 at 8:30 p.m.** on the **Budweiser Variety Free Stage**. This concert is **hosted by Radio Lobo 98.7** and is included with Fair admission.

“Los Tucanes is one of the biggest bands in Latin music today,” said Adrenna Alkhas, spokesperson for the Stanislaus County Fair. “They are performing on the last night of the Fair and it’s a great way to spice up the night for our guests.”

Los Tucanes began their musical journey over 20 years ago in Tijuana. From 1995 to 1997 they were the only Mexican regional band that sold over 5 million records in the U.S. and Mexico. In 1999 Los Tucanes was the first Mexican regional band in history to be nominated and awarded four times by the BMI in Miami. They were also the first band to receive a golden record in Chile.

More recently, in 2005, Los Tucanes signed with Univision Music Group and released their first live DVD and CD set, “Siempre Contigo.” In 2007 the band released their album of corridos, “El Papa de Los Pollitos.” This album stunned band members and the Univision Music Group when the demand for the album during the first week exceeded their predictions. The album also reached #1 on the Billboard and Sound Scanned.

The members of Los Tucanes include: Mario Quintero Lara (lead vocals), David Servin Raya (percussion), Mario Moreno Quintero (bass guitar), Clemente Flores Mondaca (keyboards and second bajo sexton), Guatavo Labrada Valenzuela (drums), and Alfredo Gonzalez Gonzalez (accordion and backup vocal).

The 2010 Fair theme is "Flavors of the Valley." The theme will highlight food and beverage products that are processed in the Central Valley. Also planned for 2010 are nightly metal-mashing motorsports and rodeo in the FoodMaxx Arena, a total of five stages of live entertainment, upwards of 30,000 local exhibits and over 1,750 animals.
