The upcoming exhibit **deadlines** for the remaining **4-H, FFA, Open Junior and Senior** departments are **Thursday, June 3rd** and **Thursday, June 10th, by 5 p.m.** This will be the final chance for exhibitors in the following divisions to enter in the competition at the 2010 Stanislaus County Fair.

The June 3rd deadline applies to the following 4-H, FFA, and Open exhibits:

- Jr. Industrial Arts
- All Open Junior and Senior entry forms (except Floriculture, Ag Horticulture and Wine & Beer)

- Open Junior and Senior Ag Horticulture
- Wine & Beer
- Floriculture (including gardens)
- Rabbits
- Poultry
- Cavies
- Dogs
